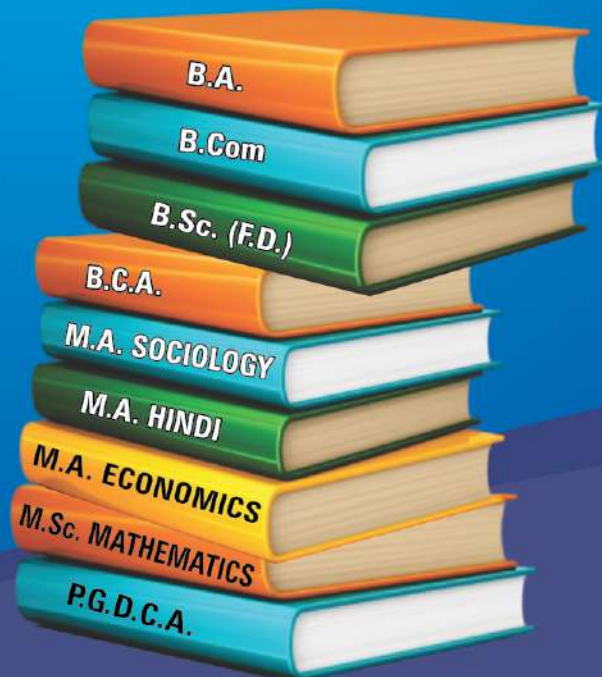

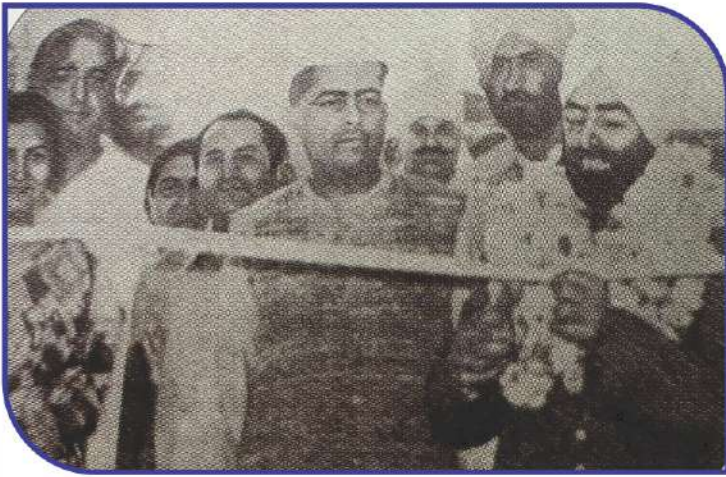

# College Profile

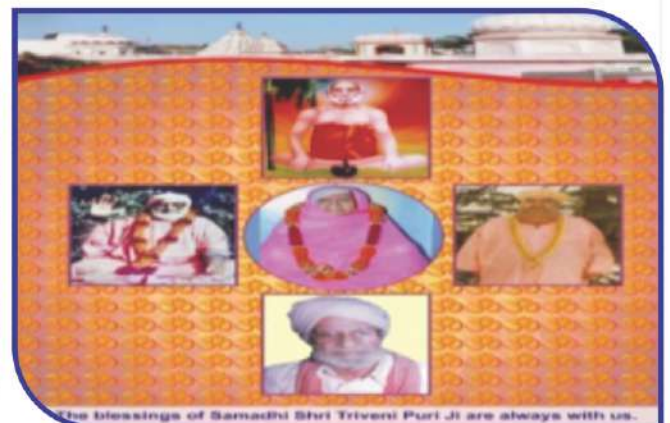

- \* **Borrowing & Returning:** A student can keep two books issued from the library at a time. Books are issued for 14 days. The book returned can be re-issued with the permission of the librarian. A fine of Rs. 2 per day is charged for late returns.
- \* **Identity:** Students receive an ID card and two Reader's tickets, which are non-transferable.
- \* **Damages:** Loss or damage to a book requires the student to bear the replacement cost.
- \* **Hours:** Photostat facility is available 10:00 am – 2:00 pm  
Book issuance facility is available: Monday to Saturday (9:30 am – 2:00 pm.)

### IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE STUDENTS

- ★ Every student must read the prospectus carefully.
- ★ Principal has full authority to approve or reject subject combinations.
- ★ BCA/B.Com students must complete the full course in same college. Migration allowed only after paying full course fee.
- ★ Students having compartments must submit original compartment certificate at the time of admission.
- ★ Student without English in +2 can take admission but must clear it later, if not cleared in two chances then admission will be cancelled.
- ★ It is mandatory for all the students to be present at the general assembly held weekly.

## FEE CONCESSION AND SCHOLARSHIPS
